Your help in making this available is through your advertising support in the Programme and taking advantage of the 5,000 plus people who attend the Games to advertise you company or organisation.

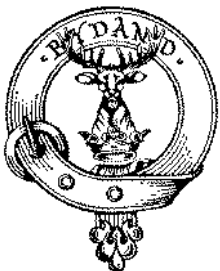

Stall Holder Conditions, Obligations and Information

The criteria for vendors is set-out below.

* Vendors must have a Scottish/Nova Scotian/Celtic theme or have a local Waipu content.

* All applicants must be approved by the Caledonian Committee

* Sites will be allocated on a "first come first served" basis

PLEASE NOTE: YOU ARE NOT ALLOWED TO SET-UP ANYWHERE OTHER THAN YOUR ALLOCATED SITE!

- * Sites will be marked with your Company or Society name prior to the Games.
- * No site operator may have any part of their structure, including tent pegs, overlapping the site.
- * All food operators will be required to provide all necessary Health Dept. and Council certificates
- * Please advise the Site Steward if you wish to distribute any advertising material or run a raffle from your site.
- * You will need to provide your own tents, tables and extension power cables if required.
- * Sorry, NO pets or animals are allowed on the Park - exceptions are Guide Dogs and exhibition animals.

ALL site holders and staff must have gate passes and our security staff will not allow entry to the Caledonian Park without the correct pass. Passes may be ordered with site application. You may set-up your site on Hogmanay Day, the 31st December and our Security staff will be in attendance to monitor your site at no extra cost to you.

NOTES FOR 2010 GAMES

- The traditional March in of the Clans will take place at 9.30am on Jan 1st 2010
- Meet in the car park at the monuments in the main street at 9.20am
- Maximum of 6 clan members from each Clan.
- Participants to wear kilts or tidy clothing. **NO SANDALS/JANDALS/THONGS OR SHORTS PLEASE!**
- Parade will be led by the Waipu Highland Pipe Band
- Details of the march will be outlined prior to march off by the Parade Marshall, Mr Wayne Laurence or assistant, who will be in attendance.
- The Honour guard will be provided by Clan Donald preceded by representatives of the Host Clan
- Salute to the Chief will take place inside the Caledonian Park.
- Caledonian Chief Pipe Major Bain McGregor will take the salute with invited VIPs
- Massed lunchtime parade prior to official opening will assemble at Bowling club end of the park
- Assemble at 12.25pm, parade will march off as soon as assembled.
- Dame Catherine Tizard will Open the 139th Games
- Dewars' Ceilidh tickets - Jan 1st, cost \$5, available from the office during the games. The Ceilidh will be organised by the Waipu Pipe Band.
